#### News from the Parish Council and Recreation Field Trust



The Parish Council was able to hold its first informal Zoom meeting in June. Now that remote meetings legislation has expired and we have a scheme of delegation, this is how we plan to ensure it is 'business as usual' until we can hopefully get back to face to face meetings in September. Everyone is welcome to attend as usual - the next informal meeting will be on 20th July and all details are published on the website <a href="www.mistertonparishcouncil.org.uk">www.mistertonparishcouncil.org.uk</a>. Remember that the Parish Council does not meet in August and we will circulate details of the September meeting closer to the time.

Thank you to a couple of local volunteers who strimmed and trimmed the lane behind Cedric's - if you do spot an issue with the local footpaths, please do let us know as the Parish Council employs a Parish Ranger. If we know about it, we can ask her to attend to the issue on her days in the village.

We would like to thank Misterton Football Club for their efforts again this year in helping to keep the Recreation Ground green and healthy. You may have seen our tree surgeons around undertaking the third year of tree works - these were identified by our arborist in a tree management plan for the village. Some trees are being removed for safety reasons or to allow others to flourish; some are being coppiced which looks drastic but actually will ensure longevity and better, healthier growth. We do plant dozens of trees in the Parish each year and hope to plant an additional fifteen in the autumn. The Parish Council was also pleased to be able to donate fifteen rowan and silver birch trees to the Old Mills estate for their communal green space.

#### Misterton Emergency and Resilience Team update

The Misterton Emergency and Resilience Team (MERT) continue to address potential flooding issues in the village. To progress this we met in the week with representatives from Somerset County Council (SCC) and walked around the village looking at the areas that suffer most when we get heavy rain.

The positives that came from the meeting was their interest in our village and that they are already aware of many of the issues we have to deal with. One of the challenges is that the Highways Department contract out the work so when it comes to drains they use three different subcontractors to flush out drains, identify blockages between drains and then clear those blockages.

Inevitably SCC cannot offer immediate solutions to flooding problems, rather they will continue to work with us to improve things where possible. Their message is that the community should continue to report all problems we come across to council via their website https://www.somerset.gov.uk/contact-us/.

MERT will also continue to work on this and thanks to those who have provided information and photographs regarding past flooding incidents as they all add to the evidence we have. More experiences are welcome so please let us know what you have.

On 14th August Misterton is having another sale day and MERT will have a table on located on lain's drive at Laburnum, Silver Street. Money raised will go to good causes in the village, including supporting the activities of the MERT team.

Hopefully next month Covid regulations will be relaxed to the point where the village can meet up again and when this happens we have some plans to provide training on how to use defibrillators for those who would like to practice just in case the need arises. More on this in due course. In the meantime please stay safe.



It does mean that we have had to postpone the planned public meeting about the future of St Leonard's. I am glad I have you guys on my side ""



#### John Coquet (by Sue Coquet, his wife for 55 years)

John's paternal grandparents, Romain and Pharailde, arrived in England with their five children as refugees after the Germans invaded Belgium where they then lived. It was the second time that Coquets came here. At some point in the 13th or 14th century they bought or, more likely, stole what is now Coquet Island off the Northumberland coast.

John was born in a Sussex village in 1941 and can just remember sheltering on the steps of the house's flooded cellar as German planes flew over on their way to bomb London. He also saw tanks and troops coming down the village road on their way to the D-Day landings. There was an Italian prisoner of war camp on the outskirts of the village. His mother used to take him there to let the POWs hand him through the barbed wire the little toys they had made for him.

His first memory of his father, Joe, was when he arrived in the village after being demobbed in 1946. The Royal Artilleryman had fought in North Africa, and then in Italy where he was involved in the battle of Monte Cassino. Later, in Germany, he guarded SS prisoners. Apart from a scorpion bite sustained in the desert, he was unwounded.

The family moved to Wandsworth in London where John went to a prep school and then a grammar school, both in Wimbledon. Some years later, they moved to New Malden in Surrey, just down the road from where I lived. I can vividly remember fancying him as I trailed down the road behind him — I on my way to school and he on his way to the station to take the train to work. They then moved to nearby Worcester Park.


He worked at the insurance market, Lloyd's of London, before moving to a marine insurance company in the City. Having passed his professional insurance exams, he eventually became a marine underwriter, occasionally writing articles for insurance magazines.

We met at a party where John was with his then-fiancée. When he left home in 1962, I used to visit him in a succession of invariably squalid flats and bed-sits that he sometimes shared with a mate. He proposed to me in Trafalgar Square, but still maintains that it was I who proposed!

We were married in 1966 and lived in Horsham, Sussex. Our son, Nick, was born there. Kirstin, our daughter, was born soon after we moved to Crawley in 1972. Nick now lives in Brighton, Kirstin in Croydon. John found the commuting from Sussex a pain, so we moved again -- this time back to New Malden and to be near our families.

John then worked for a series of insurance companies -- Arab-owned, British, American, and French, now as an aviation underwriter insuring aircraft in more than a hundred countries. He did a fair bit of business travelling during his career. He worked for a few months in Jamaica and the Dutch West Indies and went to the USA, France (about thirty times while working for the French company), Spain, Switzerland, Holland, and Poland.

We stayed in New Malden until John retired, moving in 2000 to The Old Coach House in Misterton where we had owned a weekend cottage in Middle Street for several years.



He has always had strange and varied interests. Scandinavian Keen mythology, he once hitch-hiked around old Viking Norway in search of settlements. He even wanted to name our first house Odinheim after the chief Nordic god, but I soon put a stop to that. He was also a member of the Witchcraft Research Association, corresponding with a witch in the New Forest. Hitchhiking was very much his thing before we married. He spent a fortnight with a flatmate travelling through England, Scotland, and Wales, sleeping in fields, in bus shelters and on golf courses. Once, in desperation, they asked at a King's Lynn police station where they could spend the night. They wound up sleeping in an empty cell, and a policeman was kind enough to bring them cups of tea in the morning. Most weekends they went hitch-hiking, mainly to Sidmouth for some reason. Absolutely not my thing.

He has been involved in many different sports in his time. Three of them – rugby, boxing, and cricket, unwillingly at school. Then tennis, table-tennis, archery, fencing, rifle shooting, badminton, and golf.

He once had a Lambretta scooter. I rode pillion on it — no crash helmets in those days. Illegally too, as he had not yet passed his test. Later, he had a Harley Davidson motorbike, which he sold soon after he retired, claiming that the local roads were not suitable for Harleys. His favourite author is Kingsley Amis, and his favourite band is The Rolling Stones. John has involved himself in painting and fretwork since his retirement. He has also published three novels.


