#### News from the Parish Council and Recreation Field Trust



As I near my first anniversary as both councillor and chairman of Misterton Parish Council (MPC) I must report that our monthly meeting yesterday was as busy and, I hope, successful as previously. First, I add my thanks to all who helped with our village clear up, particularly to our clerk and MERT for their work with the MPC. All available councillors were present and in my twenty years in the village, participation was by far and away the greatest yet. A fuller report is given by MERT. We plan another clear up in the autumn but also would encourage everyone to tidy around their own properties on the coronation weekend (May 6th - 8th) and, if they are able, to add bunting and red, white, and blue balloons so that we can show our village to the world.

Planning for the coronation event at the village hall and recreation field continues. Any residents with artistic talent are encouraged to contact me on 01460 76761. We are looking for drawings, pictures, photographs, modelling, hand crafts and flower arrangements. Our music plans are also taking shape. We plan an 'open mic' session for amateur talent from our village and surrounding villages. We have help from several villagers in the music business. There will be cash prizes but for many it will be the experience that will be most important. Anyone with an interest should contact <a href="mistertontalentshow@gmail.com">mistertontalentshow@gmail.com</a> and they will be invited to attend the new music studio to prepare their music.

At our meeting we were able to approve the costs for the long-awaited speed indicator device and this will be installed in the coming weeks. It should help the traffic problem a little but much more is needed. I proposed that the road working group needs to gather data from throughout the village and prioritise it as 1) safety of pedestrians 2) safety of property and 3) safety for motorists. One move that might help is the introduction of a 20mph speed limit throughout the village. Our county councillor advised that was not difficult to implement and that Crewkerne Town were considering a similar solution.

The cemetery working group had been busy. The chapel had been opened on both the first Sunday as planned and on Mothering Sunday. The next openings will be April 2nd and Easter Sunday. Those who had witnessed TV programmes on the death of our rivers will realise that the phosphate problem is real and is preventing the planned extension to the cemetery. Faced with a specialist bill of £2,000 which would not guarantee planning approval, the council voted to change the application for the extension to only interment until the

phosphate problem is solved by other initiatives. Finally, the gates have been removed and are being prepared for erection in a safer position.

The meeting agreed the purchase of an additional roving camera which would help in the identification of wrongdoing at the recreation field including drug taking and out of control and fouling dogs.

At the start of our meeting, we received a short presentation from Daniel Moncrieff from Somerset County Council (SCC) where he described the plans for the use of our school and the creation of associated foster homes. Councillors and four members of the public who were present were able to question him. This is early days, but many will want to monitor the progress and we have requested SCC to keep us fully informed with developments.

#### Steve Hilson

There cannot be many people who have been in a helicopter up close to Princess Anne and the late Duke of Edinburgh. And, more humbly, to the journalist, Kate Adie. But Royal Navy Lieutenant Commander Steve Hilson has. Steve moved from Langport to Misterton's Church Lane a couple of years ago. He shares the house with his wife, Jill, two dogs and two cats. He was born in 1964 in Malvern, Worcestershire. His father was a printer, and his mother worked in schools as a domestic helper. Steve has two older sisters. He went to a junior school and then to The Chase School, a comprehensive, both in Malvern. He enjoyed running, especially cross country. He also played rugby for the school as a wing three-quarter. He still keeps himself enviably fit on a treadmill, aiming for 1,000 kilometers a year.

His first job was with Kay's mail order catalogue in Worcester, at first as a buyer's assistant, then as a buyer. He also played in the company's rugby team.

He joined the Royal Navy in 1987, gaining direct entry as a midshipman, initially signing on for eight years. After moving to Dartmouth, he then went to Culdrose in Cornwall to train as an observer, first in fixed-wing aircraft before moving on to Lynx



helicopters, sitting on the left of the pilot and being responsible for weapons and tactics. As an officer he served abroad in the Baltic, USA, Antarctica, the Mediterranean, South Africa and Diego Garcia - an island in the Indian Ocean where a British naval support facility is based. Since June 2021 he has been working at Yeovilton introducing a weapons system on Wildcat helicopters. Yeovilton is one of the Navy's two principal air bases and one of the busiest military airfields in the UK. He plans to retire next year after 37 vears of service.

He met his wife in Malvern. Jill trained as a nurse in Ashford, Kent, which she still is, specializing in bowel screening at hospitals in Taunton and Yeovil. They spent their honeymoon in Jersey. They have two daughters, Emily being the elder, and Molly. Emily has two children: Arthur who is four, and Edith who was born just before last Christmas.

Steve and his wife have spent many holidays abroad, including Italy, Singapore and Greece. Their first marital home was in Weymouth, followed by Dorchester and Langport.

During his service in the Royal Navy, he played squash and golf (his father still plays golf twice a week at the age of 87). Steve used to play drums in various bands, several of them made up of schoolmates. He still has a set of electronic drums. As he says, 'It's kinder on our neighbours.' The bands concentrated on rock, blues and reggae. He has a wide variety of musical taste, enjoying bands such as Florence and the Machine and London Grammar as well as rock groups such as Rush. Indeed, his favourite record is Tom Sawyer by that Canadian rock band. In particular he admires the work of their drummer, the late Neil Peart, whose idol was Charlie Watts, the Rolling Stones' drummer who died in 2021. Steve enjoys watching TV crime series such as Vera, Line of Duty, Silent Witness and Happy Valley. He is particularly interested in books relating to history and he is currently reading an early history of England and the Anglo-Saxons. But his favourite novel is John Grisham's The Client. Subsequently, he has read all Grisham's books. Unsurprisingly, considering Steve's job, his choice of film is Top Gun and its sequel, Top Gun Maverick. As for football, he doesn't confess to follow any team in particular, but does admire the play of Manchester City.

Whilst still serving with the Royal Navy, Steve and family lived in Madrid between 2007 and 2008 where he completed the Spanish Staff Course. Jill meanwhile took the opportunity to gain a 'Teaching English as a Foreign Language' qualification. Their daughters attended a local school in Madrid and then the family moved south to Rota until 2010, near to their most-loved Spanish city, Seville. Steve still retains his 'competency' in Spanish. Perhaps mindful of his impending retirement from the Royal Navy, he has also completed an MBA degree from the Open University - Master of Business Administration. We wish him well for his future.

#### **Letter from Anne**

It is suggested to Christians in Lent to walk alongside Jesus in the wilderness as he takes time away to reflect, and to just be, and where he is tempted by the devil before he begins his ministry. The food industry is a prime example of this. Many of us over the years have bought our food and other commodities based solely on price, without really reflecting on the cause and effect of what that means.

If we took time to reflect seriously on where our food comes from, we would buy local products, meat and vegetables, in season. from local producers. If our only measure for the food we eat, and the goods we buy is its cost, then should we be surprised that unscrupulous businessmen will take advantage of that?

The mess in our food industry perhaps would never have happened if we had spent more time in quiet reflection about the consequences of our actions. Indeed, I suspect we would have stronger local economies, with more employment opportunity for our youngsters, farmers still in business, and less closed shops on our high streets. So many situations we find ourselves in today have only come about because reflecting and thinking seems to have gone out of fashion, cause and effect is being lost.

I suspect we would all benefit by spending some time in the 'wilderness' just pausing to think about the cause and effect of the decisions we make.

That way we are more able to resist temptation and be ready to celebrate Eater together.



#### Misterton Gardeners Association

Our meeting this month is on Friday 29th April at 7:30pm in the former WI hall. Our speaker is Mike Berks, the founder and Managing Director of the Sherborne Castle and Brimsmore garden centres. His subject is 'More gardening folklore'. Those who have heard Mike before know that he is a very knowledgeable, witty and entertaining speaker. So do come along and tune in to Mike for an enjoyable and fun evening.

Our flower of the month competition continues so bring along a flower from your garden. As ever new members are most welcome to join us. It is a great way to get to know others living in our village.

April is a busy month for us gardeners. With much to do in usually pleasant weather and of course longer days. Do give your shrubs and roses a feed. They have several months ahead of them, and a feed of general-purpose fertiliser will get them off to a good start. Inevitably we do get some frosts this month so if you can cover any half-hardy plants (including fruit trees) when their young buds show. Hardy annuals can be sown in pots or modules to provide colour in the garden during the summer months. And, if you have not done so, sow some tomato and courgette seeds - they will provide some great crops all summer long.

Continuing our saga about daffodils, we bought some double daffodil bulbs last November. I have always had misgivings about any flowers labelled doubles. They seem to me to be a bit unnatural - more the product of a plant breeder's enthusiasm. However, when I saw some

photos of a couple of so-called butterfly daffodils, I set my prejudices aside. And sent away for a pack named Acropolis and another called Tahiti (see picture). They are late flowering and do not come out until mid or late April so we will wait and see how they do on Misterton soils. If successful I may get some more next year as they do seem rather exotic.




