News from the Parish Council and Recreation Field Trust



When you receive this there will only be a few days to go before our planned village event for the coronation on the recreation field and in the village hall when we are hoping to see as many of you as possible. The parish council has worked hard to make sure that the access to the event and any car parking needed is free. Equally participation in the events organised will also be free.

Artists in the village have been written to inviting them to display their talent at the art show. The 'Royal' dog show will have several competing classes which will be purely for fun. We would ask dog owners wanting to join to register with the organisers (by the show ring) at least thirty minutes before the start which is scheduled for 2pm. Come and have a look at the cars, all from the village, which will be on display with the chance for you to pick your favourite - the lucky owner will get a valeting prize. The music will start with an 'open mic' where musicians in the area of all age groups are encouraged to compete for money prizes. You are welcome to bring your own picnic but if not canned drinks and alcohol will be for sale along with a hog roast and veggie burgers. We are planning many activities for the younger members including a coronation mug for all villagers under the age of 17, so please do make sure they all come along.

Finally, of course, this sort of event does take a lot of setting up and packing up and it would be greatly appreciated if as many villagers as possible could come and help from 08:00 hours onwards on the 7th. Our last council meeting, held on 18th April, continued to report successful completion of tasks in the village. The speed indicator device which was first discussed twelve years ago is now in my garage awaiting a small amount of work by Somerset County Council before it can be set up. The cemetery gates have been painted and will shortly be placed in their new position. Many other minor tasks have also been completed and by the time you receive the magazine we should have an additional powerful camera for the CCTV coverage at the recreation ground in place.

King Charles III

Our new King, Charles Philip Arthur George, will be the oldest monarch in British history to be crowned, and the first to be divorced. He married Diana, the late Princess of Wales, after meeting her only thirteen times beforehand. He was also the longest-serving heir to the throne, having been named heir at the age of three.

He was the first heir to the throne to attend school and then break a long-standing tradition by going up to Cambridge where he was awarded a degree in archaeology. He speaks Welsh, and plays the cello, piano and trumpet. An avid gardener, he is an accomplished artist who specialises in painting landscapes in watercolours. His paintings are very collectable and have brought him more than three million pounds. In his time, he has flown fixed-wing aircraft and helicopters, and was the first member of the Royal Family to be granted his RAF wings. He also served in the Royal Navy, having first enrolled in the Britannia Royal Navy College. In 1975, Charles spent an hour underwater while exploring the remains of Henry VIII's flagship, Mary Rose, which sank in the Solent in 1545. He has written a book for children, too. Its title is The Old Man of Lochnagar.

To honour his efforts to protect the world's rainforests, Charles has had his name used for a newly discovered species of frog in Ecuador. The frog's official name is Hyloscirtus princecharlesi.

In 1970, he and his sister, Princess Anne, were invited by the US President Nixon to stay at the White House for the weekend. Afterwards, he was reported to have said, 'That was the time they were trying to marry me off to the President's daughter, Tricia Nixon.' On another occasion, he sent flowers to the singer, Barbra Streisand. She later commented, 'You know, if I'd played my cards right, I could have wound up as the first Jewish princess.'



Charles is a patron, president, or a member of over 400 charities. As an example of his private generosity, he once sent a bottle of Scotch to the singer, Ozzy Osbourne, who had injured himself when his quad bike crashed. At the time, Charles was unaware that Ozzy was a recovering alcoholic. Not that it has been all about talking to flowers and stroking the trees that Charles has planted. When he was fourteen, and in a pub on the Isle of Lewis, he ordered a cherry brandy for himself. The outcome was that his bodyguard lost his job.

Our King is careful about what he eats. He refrains from eating meat or fish for two days a week. Similarly, on one day a week, he doesn't eat dairy products. One of his favourite dishes is lamb with wild-mushroom risotto. As to his recent health, and despite being fully vaccinated, he has contracted Covid-19 twice last year. He is also noted for his so-called sausage fingers, very pink and uncommonly puffy. His great-uncle, Earl Mountbatten, once urged Charles's parents to have his ears surgically pinned back. They declined to accept his advice.

One hopes that his forthcoming coronation is not a shambles as was Queen Victoria's in 1838. The ceremony in Westminster Abbey lasted a full five hours and had been entirely unrehearsed. Benjamin Disraeli said afterwards that the whole thing had left a lot to be desired. The Archbishop of Canterbury forced the coronation ring on Victoria's wrong finger. The Queen managed to get it off at last, saying later that she'd done it with the greatest difficulty and with great pain. She had to use a bowl of iced water to relieve the damaged digit. The Bishop of Durham handed her the ceremonial orb at the wrong



moment. The Bishop of Bath and Wells accidentally turned over two pages at once of the order of service, and Victoria had to call him back to make him read it properly. For some, at least, the highlight of the ceremony was a peer who tripped while ascending the altar steps and then rolled down them. Other peers retired to St Edward's chapel as part of the service, and Lord Melbourne moaned that the chapel's altar was littered with sandwiches and bottles of wine.



Apparently, the code word for King Charles' coronation is Operation Golden Orb. It is ideal, leaving no clues to puzzle over. However, we hope that King Charles' coronation is faultless. Long may he reign.

This will be my last newsletter as I have been appointed as an Associate Minister to King's Somborne, a lovely village in the Test Valley in Hampshire, and we will be leaving Crewkerne at the end of May, to return in five years' time. Rob and I would like to thank all of you in Misterton who have been so supportive over the last difficult year and look forward to renewing our friendships in 2028.



Our meeting this month is on Friday 26th May at 7:30pm in the village hall. Our speaker is Claire Hart, and her subject is 'gardening through the ages'. Those who have heard Claire before know that she is an entertaining and informative speaker with plenty of slides to show us.

Our flower of the month competition continues so bring along a flower from your garden. As ever new members are most welcome to join us. It is a great way to get to know others living in our village.

May is my favourite month in the garden. Long daylight hours, pleasant weather for the most part, with everything in the garden coming to life. Of course, there is the prospect early in the month of a May frost. So, protect half-hardy annuals and any tender shoots popping their heads out of the ground. Similarly earth up your early potatoes. Weeds are growing too so get to work on them. If you are tempted to clip your hedges, check first for any nesting birds.

A final few words about daffodils. What a wonderful species they are. They are so varied and give all of us so many months of winter and early spring pleasure. Although we think of them as typically English, Spain has the greatest variety of species, and they are also found in North Africa. They grow in many habitats ranging from sea level areas to sub-alpine meadows. They are almost over in Misterton now, but we always look out for one or two flowering in May. Pheasants Eye (see photo) is the most reliable if you want a really late flowering daff.


