#### News from the Parish Council and Recreation Field Trust



Last month I submitted the parish council annual report that I had made available for the May AGM. In addition, our celebration of the coronation of King Charles III was separately reported in the middle pages of this excellent magazine. I thought it gave a wonderful summary of the event, but I take no credit. The concept and photographs were those of our magazine editors; I was just asked to provide a 200-word summary of the event and was amazed how well it all came together. The National Lottery, one of our sponsors, and our Lord Lieutenant had both asked for photographs of our celebrations and our clerk has gained approval to send those from the magazine.

I am in no doubt that our magazine is an enormous benefit to the village and should be protected and preserved. No other local town or villages benefits from a monthly independent magazine such as ours. I trust you all agree with me.

Our coronation event is nearly concluded. Despite all efforts to keep costs to a minimum, we made profits of £2,100 which will be returned to village amenities. Our Misterton coronation mug will soon be distributed freely to all the Misterton residents' children that registered during the event. Hopefully it will be a lifelong reminder of the children's events that were enjoyed so much during the celebrations. The parish council's efforts to celebrate the coronation worked well but it is for others if they wish to answer the calls for future fetes or other community events. Small grants may be available from the parish council with requests considered on a case-by-case basis.

Our council tasks are continuing. We believe we have succeeded with revised planning approval for our cemetery extension but that needs a couple more weeks for final approval. Hopefully I will be able to confirm this in the next edition and also report that the SID is up and running - we are currently still waiting for the posts to be installed.

#### Misterton Gardeners Association

We have no formal speaker this month. Instead, we are planning to hold a garden party. The venue has still to be decided, as is the date. This is because we are so weather dependent and obviously do not want to hold this when we are likely to be deluged by rain (or for that matter during a heatwave). Probably it will be on a Sunday afternoon. Members will all be notified when details are finalised.

July is often the hottest month of the year and a great time to be sitting out in your garden after all the hard work in earlier months. Inevitably there are some things to be done. So, keep your plants looking good by regular dead heading as in this way you will enjoy a longer season of top-class blooms. Perhaps the most important other thing to do is to keep watering your plants, especially those you have put in in the spring. Feed them regularly too, with a general-purpose fertiliser such as Tomorite.

Finally, roses. I think they have been superb this year. Some seem to go on and on. One of these is called deep secret (see photo). Not only does it continue to flower for many weeks, but it also changes colour from a deep dark red to a more vibrant crimson colour. I don't know what causes this - it may be the weather or changes in the daylight hours.

#### **Arthur Henry Knighton-Hammond**

Over the years most of us have been up the pathway leading to Misterton church. But have we ever peered into the drive on its right-hand side? This leads to the house known as The Old Court which is thought to be oldest house in Misterton. It was once the home of a famous painter named Arthur Knighton-Hammond.

The Old Court is now divided into four but in Knighton-Hammond's day (he lived there from 1940 to 1955) it was all one. With the usual array of maids, cooks and so on. They included the parents of Betty Symes, who still lives in Silver Street. Betty's father was the head gardener at The Old Court and along with his family lived in the house which we now know as Finials.

Arthur Hammond - he added Knighton (his mother's maiden name) and the hyphen later by deed poll as he thought it more distinctive - was born in 1875 at Arnold near Nottingham. He left school when he was eleven and worked at his brother's grocery store and then served an apprenticeship as a watchmaker, a job he hated. In the evenings he studied at the Nottingham School of Art. There he started painting and became determined to make a living out of it. He moved to an art school in London. And began to paint (both using oils and watercolours) picture postcards and then horses and hunting

Knighton-Hammond saw opportunities in painting industrial landscapes and it was this that gave him his biggest break when he was given a commission to paint these in the USA by the Dow Corporation. Later another break came his way - an instruction by the former Prime Minister David Lloyd George to paint a life-size

portrait of himself. He and Lloyd George subsequently became personal friends. His works were shown in the Tate Gallery as well as galleries in Paris, New York, and South Africa. In the 1930s he reverted to his first love, landscapes and the use of watercolours. A passion which he continued on his move to Misterton.

The 15 years that Knighton-Hammond spent in Misterton were extremely

prolific in terms of the numbers of watercolour paintings he churned out. Some of which were donated to local people who helped him, including the father of my wife Diana who was a Crewkerne GP. The farmland adjacent to The Old Court provided a vast array of characters, animals, and farming activities all of which he relished. He bought some of the adjoining land and for a while had a

couple of cows and some chickens. He loved the landscape setting of Henley, Wayford and of Kingshays Barton and painted the farmer there (Johnny Jeffrey) at his work. He disliked being overlooked when he was painting, and teenager Betty thought he was quite grumpy. On one occasion he painted Betty and her mother outside their house, but the painting cannot be traced. Grumpy or not, on a number of occasions Misterton's village fete was held on the lawn of The Old Court.

We never saw much of him during the winter months and there was a rumour that he hibernated. The reality is that he disliked the winter light of England and went to the South of France - certainly a number of his paintings are of Menton right on the Italian border. To this day, Menton is noted for its winter light. Eventually The Old Court became too much for an 80-year-old. But he loved the rolling countryside of our area and the inspiration which it gave him. So, he sold up and bought Higher Farm in neighbouring Seaborough. He converted a barn into a studio and gave lessons to budding young painters. His talents were recognised when he was featured in a live television broadcast from the studio barn featuring him amongst his collection of paintings. He died at Seaborough in 1970 aged 94.

Today his paintings are largely out of favour. But they are still semi-collectables and crop up at local sales like Lawrences from time to time. However, throughout his lifetime Knighton-Hammond was widely recognised and feted by many including politicians and European royal families. The famous artist Augustus John said of him "He is the greatest artist in watercolours of our lifetime". His paintings are still hung



#### **Garden recycling collections**

Gardening season is here, time to sign up to a garden recycling collection.

The service is run by Somerset Council and with spring well and truly here and gardens bursting into life, now is the perfect time to sign up.

Subscriptions can be started any time during the year and the quickest and easiest way to subscribe is online through the <a href="mailto:somerset.gov.uk/waste">somerset.gov.uk/waste</a> page - just use the 'Do it online/My Waste Service' feature.

Collections are made fortnightly year-round (apart from a short break during Christmas and New Year) and residents can either sign up to a pre-paid 180-litre wheeled bin or 90-litre compostable paper sacks. The price of a wheeled bin subscription for 2023/24 is £63.50 for 25 collections and for packs of ten garden waste sacks, £31.10.

#### The future of St Leonard's Church

I know how much St Leonard's church is loved in the village and I have been asked to write something about its future. This is because, as you may know, those who have been managing the practicalities of church life have quite rightly now handed them over to me to manage directly. I am so grateful to them for their very valiant efforts over a long period of time. However, we are now in the unusual situation of having no church officers, so it falls to me to find a way of managing things, because I am the rector of the Crewkerne benefice, which means that I am also vicar of Misterton and the other villages around Crewkerne.

What does this mean in practice?

Well, in the short to medium term it means that I will try to keep running St Leonard's, as far as I have resources to hand from Crewkerne parish. So we will seek to provide services on Sundays (presently twice a month, on the second and third Sundays) together with weddings, funerals and so on, as usual. It is only realistic to recognise that limited resources may have an effect but we will do our best!

Longer term, we need to have a conversation about how to manage the church's future and how to provide for Misterton best spiritually over the years ahead. We will be discussing that as we go on together.


