News from the Parish Council and Recreation Field Trust



When we decided to cancel our planned July parish council meeting because both the clerk and I were scheduled to be away for several weeks, we reinstituted an August meeting. At the time we did not anticipate there would be so much to report but there is, and I will try my best to be succinct.

The finance working group held a successful quarterly meeting to monitor progress and made two recommendations for MPC approval. These were to transfer £25,000 of our funds to our interest-bearing account and to set up a digital account with a monthly transfer of £3,500 to make regular payments easier without risking security for the majority of the funds that we hold on your behalf. We have also benefited from a substantial VAT repayment which will help pay for future unplanned tasks such as tree felling and necessary hedge cutting back.

There is good news on the cemetery in that, having modified our planning application, we now have approval to use the extension as a garden of remembrance for interments only. This change has been necessary because recent laws on phosphates prevented the original concept. We shall be formulating future tasks to recover land for the cemetery from many years of encroachment by the boundary hedges. In the meantime, increasing the number of grass cuts and opening the chapel at the beginning of each month seems well received.

We continue to check the recreation grounds and its facilities on a regular basis. As with the cemetery we have increased the frequency of grass cutting. It may not be widely known that for some time CCTV cameras have monitored and recorded views of the car park. More recently we have added a move accurate camera that covers the whole area and reacts to movement. There are four images recorded constantly and we are looking at the best way to combine monitoring the past images into our regular checks. We are also aware of essential work to cut back/down trees and hedges on the recreation ground and are preparing a programme of works.

Our road working group has drawn up a spreadsheet in our efforts to make the village more liveable and most importantly, safer. We are asking for help from everyone. If you witness vehicles driving on the pavement (which is a criminal offence) or other bad driving, please send photographic evidence to our clerk (mistertonpc@gmail.com). We will do the rest which may include requesting the police to take action. The road through our village is historic and was built for horse and cart. It falls woefully short of the government requirements of an HGV route, yet the county council still proceeded with the designation. On high-risk areas such as Tunnel Steps we are seeking quick return solutions. Any information we receive on changes to our roads, closures etc. we post on the MPC website

immediately we are made aware. Please check here regularly.

Finally, I am disappointed to have to report criminal behaviour by residents in our community. Recently this has entailed damage to the telephone box bookstore, stripping the bark off trees in Old Mill Estate and human excrement on our paths. Our problem with the irresponsible behaviour of some dog owners not taking away their dog excrement continues and must stop. The fine for anyone caught is £1,000. If there is no improvement, we may have to consider closing the recreation grounds to dogs.

September is usually a cooler month than August and of course the days are getting shorter. Perhaps there is not too much to do in the flower beds this month but if you have a fruit or flower patch you will be gathering much of the rewards of your earlier hard work. Dig up any remaining potatoes or the slugs will get at them. Some of the earlier maturing apples are ready for picking, as are almost all plums. Go blackberrying; we have many places in and around Misterton where you can gather fruits from the wild. Many of our local lanes and walks have hedges full of blackberries this month. It was always something that many villagers did when I was young. And of course, these days most of us have freezers - blackberries freeze splendidly.

There are some flowers which come into their own this month. Michaelmas daisies (or asters

to give them their proper name) add so much flower power to our gardens in September. There are a huge number of cultivars available with different heights and flower sizes but all carrying a huge array of daisy-type blooms. Thev come in many colours - white, pink, purple, red, and blue. The colour latter favourite, like those in this photo.




